The Columbus Chapter of the American Guild of Organists presents Andrew Kotylo in concert on **Sunday, March 10, 3:00 p.m.** at Broad Street United Methodist Church, 501 East Broad Street, Columbus. Kotylo will play works by Jongen, Saint-Seans, Hebble, Wright, Brahms and Rossini.

There will also be a Masterclass focusing on the organ music of Searle Wright at Broad Street United Methodist on **Saturday, March 9, 10:00 a.m. to noon.** (Welcome and refreshments at 9:30 a.m.). Searle Wright's career as an organist was unique in the pipe organ world as he combined his classical skills as teacher, performer and composer with his outstanding skills as a theater organist, for which he was well respected around the world.

Kotylo's workshop will combine a multimedia presentation with photos, musical examples and audio as well as at the console. In addition, each participant will receive a detailed handout on his presentation.
