In May of 2007 at Storrs, CT, Ms. Steele placed first in the L. Cameron Johnson Memorial Organ Competition for high school students. From 2007-2008, she served as organ scholar at the Church of the Covenant in Cleveland. Ms. Steele's other interests include traveling, reading, and Italian cuisine.*
